## PARENT/STUDENT ORIENTATION DETAILS 2020-2021

Parkway Christian Academy will facilitate an "open-house" orientation model on Friday, August 21 from 9 am to 3 pm for grades 1-12. K5 orientation will be Monday, August 24, from 8:15-9:30 am. K4 orientation will be Thursday, August 27 from 8:15-9:30 am. More details will be forthcoming regarding K4/K5 orientations in the coming weeks.

This will be an opportunity for students to come in, meet their teachers, pick up their schedules and books, and orient themselves for the first day of school on Monday. Please note the following guidelines for orientation day:

- All students and at least one parent are required to attend during these hours.
- Face coverings must be worn while on campus for all parents and students in fourth grade and above.
- Please plan on a 30- minute visit for grades 1-3. Please plan on an hour visit for grades 4-8. Please plan on a 30 -minute visit for grades 9-12.
- Vital information to the start, continuance, and success of the school year will be provided at orientation. 4-12 students will go to each teacher's classroom to pick up their books and meet the teacher for that specific class. Teachers will give out important details regarding class expectations to parents at each pick up.
- All students are required to attend the drop- in style orientation. Attendance will be taken. This includes PCA Live students. It is very important that students have the opportunity to meet their teachers in person and pick up their books before beginning Live on Monday, August 24.
- More details about orientation day will be released in the coming weeks.

PCA will release a general orientation video that must be watched before the first day of school. This video will be released on Friday, August 21 and will explain general guidelines such as car line, temperature checks, and first day of school procedures.
