Parent Orientation: Monday, August 16

Parents of **ALL K4-5th grade students** should attend parent orientation on August 16. There will be sessions at **3:00 pm, 4:15 pm and 5:30 pm**. New and returning families (parents only) are encouraged to attend one of these sessions (one session for each of your elementary children). These sessions will be held in the teachers' classrooms and should not last more than 50 minutes. Topics such as car line, using FACTS parent's portal and specific class information will be presented. Feel free to bring your student's supplies this night or during the Meet the Teacher time on August 17. Agendas and student packets will be distributed during these sessions.

All elementary parents are strongly encouraged to attend one session per child. Each session will be tailored for the specific grade with about ten minutes of general overlap information presented. If you have children in multiple grade levels this will allow you to visit all of the sessions. If you have more than three children in elementary, please contact the school office via email (info@pcalakeland.org) to determine which grade levels to visit.

Parents of **ALL 6th-12th grade students** are strongly encouraged to attend a general informational meeting with Mrs. Guiel in the Parkway Baptist Church auditorium at **6:30 pm on Monday evening, August 16**. Mrs. Guiel, the school principal, Mr. Battle, PCA's financial director, and the school nurses, Mrs. Grant and Mrs. Reed will be presenting important information crucial to starting the year off on the right track.

These meetings on Monday, August 16 are intended for parents only. Students should remain at home.

Meet the Teacher Day: Tuesday, August 17
