Position Title: High School Math Teacher

Required Spiritual Qualities

It is expected that the high school math teacher will:

- Maintaining a Christ-like example in daily living for your students and co-workers.
- Believe and actively support the **Statement of Faith of Parkway Baptist Church and Parkway Christian Academy** (attached).
- Actively participate and attend Parkway Baptist Church or a local church of like faith.

Required Professional Qualities

It is expected that the high school math teacher will:

- Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited postsecondary institution or is willing to participate in a program to complete such a degree within a specified time period.
- Ability to qualify for certification from accreditation agencies such as the American Association of Christian Schools (AACCS), Florida Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (FACCS), or Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) or is willing to participate in a program to complete the requirements for certification within a specified time period.
- Demonstrate a reasonable level of computer literacy. Basic proficiency is needed in word processing, e-mailing, and accessing the Internet, ability to learn web-based student management systems such as FACTS.
- Possess evidence of other adequate preparation, background, or experience as determined by the school administrator.

Required Personal Qualities

It is expected that the high school math teacher will:

- Have a passionate commitment to K-12 education.
- Have the spiritual maturity, academic ability, and personal leadership qualities to "train up a child in the way he should go."
- Be an enthusiastic visionary, encouraging, self-starter with a high energy level.
- Be able to command the respect of all the school's constituencies, especially the students and their parents, the teachers and staff, and the pastoral staff
- Develop and maintain rapport with students, parents, and staff by treating others with courtesy, patience, friendliness, dignity, respect, and a good sense of humor.
- Understand the importance of discernment, discretion, and confidentiality in the operation of the

classroom and school.
